#### Concord Union Baptist Association:



The tent and trailer were donated to Concord Union by the LBC Evangelism Team some years ago. The tent is worn and used on average only once a year. The funds received from the sell of the trailer with the tent will be combined with \$1,173.98, currently in the Tent Ministry account and transferred into the designated Evangelism account to be used for evangelism purposes in our association.
